## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

Product	Linseed Oil- Raw
Туре	Natural oil
Intended Use	Ideal for oiling cricket bats, adding to paint and softening metal glazing putty. Not suitable for oiling furniture or wooden floors. For furniture use <b>Rustin's Danish Oil</b> or <b>Teak Oil</b> . For floors use <b>Rustin's Floor Oil</b> .
Special Features	Natural product
Preparation	Ensure surface to be oiled is clean and dry.
Application	Apply with a rag or brush and wipe off excess with a dry rag or cloth.
Coats	As required.
Drying Time	Slow drying. Dependant on temperature, humidity and film thickness. For faster drying linseed oil use <b>Rustin's Boiled Oil</b> .
Re-coating Time	Recoat once oil has dried
Application Temp.	Ideally 15-25°C. Do not use below 15°C, or in conditions of high humidity.
Coverage	13-15 sq.m per litre, 1 coat, depending on the absorbency of the wood.
Maintenance	Re-oil periodically.
Compatibility	Compatible with most oil based products. Refer to manufacturer before mixing with other oils or varnishes.
Settlement	Stir before use.
Shelf- life/Storage	The shelf life of the product in an airtight container is a very long period of time. It is preferable to store the pro in a cool dry place.
Hazards	Low Hazard. See Health & Safety data sheets. Important: Rags used for oiling should be laid out flat to dry; otherwise they may catch fire due to spontaneous combustion
Clean-Up	Clean brushes with White Spirit or Rustin's Brush Cleaner.
