

PRODUCT DATA SHEET

Product	Strypit – New Formula
Type	Non Caustic. Dichloromethane free paint and varnish stripper.
Intended Use	For removing paint, varnish, cellulose, polyurethane, emulsion, French Polish, lacquer and textured finishes from wood, metal, glass or plaster.
Special Features	Specially formulated to avoid stripping the attractive patina acquired through age on old furniture. Free from acid and caustic.
Preparation	Ensure suitable safety protection is worn prior to commencing job.
Application	Brush on a thin coat of Strypit to provide a “key”. Dab on a second application liberally after 10 minutes. Test with a knife before scraping to ensure the paint is completely penetrated. Do not allow the surface to dry up. Apply a second liberal coat and ensure that this is worked into the blistered, softened paint. Leave for further 35 to 40 minutes. The paint/varnish should now be free from the surface and easy to remove. If not apply more Strypit . On curved surfaces or mouldings use a wire brush or steel wool.
Coats	Apply 2 or more liberal applications depending on finish and substrate. On old paint or very heavy applications Strypit can be left on longer to maximise application.
Drying Time	Do not allow surface to dry during stripping. Apply more product if necessary.
Re-coating Time	Apply second application after 10 minutes. Repeat after 35-40 minutes if paint not fully stripped.
Application Temp.	Ideally 15-25°C.
Coverage	1 litre will remove approximately 5 square meters.
Maintenance	N/A
Compatibility	Should not be used on certain plastics or fibre glass.
Settlement	Shake well before use.
Shelf-life/Storage	The shelf life of the product in an airtight container is a very long period of time. Store the product in a cool dry place.
Hazards	Highly Flammable. Keep away from all source of ignition – NO SMOKING. Keep out of reach of children. Do not breathe vapour. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. In case of contact with eyes rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. After contact with skin wash immediately with plenty of water. Clean-Up	After stripping, wooden surfaces should be rubbed with the grain with grade 2 or grade 3 steel wool and white spirit and then wiped with a clean rag. On all other surfaces wipe with a clean rag and water. Water can be used on wooden surfaces, but would cause the grain to swell. Clean brushes using White Spirit or water.
