To whom it may concern:

Rapid Electronics Ltd (REL) Policy regarding: “Conflict Materials from the Democratic Republic of Congo” (DRC) Dodd Frank Act (Section 1502)

REL is a supporter of the principles and intentions of this **US legislation** regarding the responsible sourcing of minerals in order to prevent the exploitation by oppressive regimes such as those from the DRC and which includes the raw minerals for Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten and Gold.

This legislation is not an **EU** or **UK** legal requirement and forms no obligation on **REL** to complete any due diligence research, however, **REL** is aware that many of our customers deal directly or indirectly with the **US** and consequently we have taken the following action to address this important issue.

We have amended the terms and conditions of our supplier agreement to the effect that the products they manufacture or supply must conform with the responsible sourcing of such mineral seriously and if in any doubt, inform us of any products that may not comply.

We have received no such reservations.

We rely entirely on our suppliers to advise us of any instances of non – compliance with any regulations and will take immediate necessary action regarding removal from our portfolio of products should such an advisement occur.

REL hopes that this assurance will meet with the approval of our customers whilst operating within legal obligations
